- Excessive crook or sweep is not accepted. The pole must stay within a line passing through the center of the butt and top. Double sweep, dog legs or sharp deviations from straight is not acceptable.
- Excessive quantities of knots or excessively large knots that decrease the strength of the pole are not acceptable (10" sum in 1' section or one 3" knot).

- Excessive quantities of knots or excessively large knots **ARE** acceptable

HEMLOCK LOG SPECS :

- **9" Min diameter inside bark**
- 10', 12', 14' and 16' lengths 6" trim
- 30" maximum butt diameter
- maximum 5 % butt rot
- **excessive sweep unacceptable**
- knots cut flush with stem
- no knot pulls (mechanical delimber)
- no shake
- defects such as porcupine chews, dog legs and seams are unacceptable
